Cost & Schedule

◇ \$1.6 Million

◇ Extensive environmental reviews have been completed and all permits are in place (SHPO Compliance; NYSDEC Natural Heritage and Region 9, USEPA/IPAC; Coastal Zone Management Consistency Review and Department of the Army)

◇ Plans, Specifications and Estimate are being finalized and reviewed

◇ Construction project will be advertised September 7th

◇ Bids will be opened September 28th

◇ Construction work will likely begin this season with removal of invasive species

◇ Completion by the fall of 2017

Key Features

- ◇ Pavement repairs and an asphalt concrete overlay (1 mile)
- ◇ Removal of invasive and non-invasive plants and trees along the shoreline
- ◇ 160+ tree plantings (Ozark Witch-hazel, Quaking Aspens, Eastern White Pines – see below)
- ◇ Generous areas of meadow mix and new sod
- ◇ Lookout garden with seat walls and colored sports-surfacing on pathways
- ◇ Shoreline protection and timber curb replacements
- ◇ LED site lighting
- ◇ Public art – bench mosaics and pavement painting
- ◇ Spur from Unity Island Park parking lot to main trail
- ◇ Replacement of the BSA outfall structure and the installation of fencing
- ◇ Signs, pavement markings and wayfinding
- ◇ Railing repairs and bollard replacements
